Snyder of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said G. H. Snyder, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:- Lots No. One hundred and forty four and One hundred and forty six, Connecticut Street. (144 and 146).

And I, J. A. Wakefield Jr., aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of five hundred dollars, to said G. H. Snyder, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
