

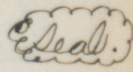
Know all Men by these Presents, That I, George Gilbert of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by N. D. Howland, of Lawrence Kansas, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Howland, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:

Number ninety three (93) Massachusetts Street.

And I, George Gilbert, aforesaid, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars, to N. D. Howland, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
