

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Saml. G. Tappan, of the Town of Lawrence, State of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and sixty dollars, to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of aforesaid place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Henry Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit: Lot No. Thirty five (35) Vermont Street.

And I, Saml. G. Tappan, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five hundred dollars, to said Henry Campbell, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
