 right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the follow-  
 ing described land, situate and lying in the Town  
 of Lawrence in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made  
 by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to wit:-

Lot No. eighty nine Rhode Island Street, (89).

And I, A. M. Simpson, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,  
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by  
 these presents in the sum of One hundred dollars, to said  
 Am. Cleland, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators  
 and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto  
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from the <sup>Trustees</sup>  
 of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person  
 or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described  
 property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges  
 and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
