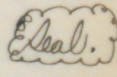


Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Samuel G. Tappan, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, Gentleman, in consideration of Fifty five dollars to me paid by George W. Collamore of Lawrence, aforesaid, Counsellor at Law, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, convey and quit claim unto the said Collamore his heirs and assigns a certain piece or parcel of land situate ^{in Lawrence, aforesaid, as described} as follows, viz: -
 One lot or parcel of land situate on Tennessee Street, and numbered fifteen on said Tennessee Street, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging. Said lot or parcel of land is shown on a plat of the said Town or City of Lawrence, surveyed by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, and numbered fifteen Tennessee St. on said plat.

To Have and to Hold the above released premises to the said Collamore and his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said Tappan, for myself and my heirs and executors, and administrators do covenant with the said Collamore his heirs and assigns that the premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me. And that I will, and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Collamore his heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by, through, or under me but against none other.

In witness whereof, I the said Samuel G. Tappan, have hereto set my hand and seal this fifth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven.
