

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Alphonzo Jones, near
the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of
the sum of Ninety dollars, to me in hand paid by Henry Learned of
the Town of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have sold, conveyed, quit-claim, and given up possession
of, and by these presents do sell, convey, quit-claim and give up
possession of, unto the said Learned, and to his heirs and assigns,^{forever},
a certain lot or parcel of land situate and lying in the Town of
Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, designated according to the
Lithographed Chart of said Town, as surveyed by A. D. Pearl, A. D.
1854, as follows, to-wit:-

Lot number Thirty-eight (38) New Hampshire Street,
together with all and singular the privileges and appurte-
nances thereunto belonging. And also all the estate, right, title, interest
and claim whatsoever, as well in law as in equity of the said
Jones, of in or to the above described premises. And I the
said Jones for myself, for my heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns, do covenant and agree, to and with the said
Learned, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
that I have not made, done, or suffered any action thing
whereby the above described premises, or any part thereof, now
are, or at any time hereafter, shall be conveyed, quit-claimed,
or encumbered in any manner whatsoever.

And be it further known by these Presents, That
I, the said Jones am held and firmly bound unto the
said Learned, his heirs and assigns, in the sum of two
hundred dollars, to be paid unto the said Learned his heirs,
assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made &
bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns
by these Presents.

Now the condition of this obligation is such,
that if the said Jones, his heirs or assigns, shall convey
unto the said Learned, his heirs or assigns, whatever
