

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Henry Campbell, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, Gentleman, in consideration of Fifty dollars to me paid by George W. Collamore, of Lawrence, aforesaid, Counsellor at Law, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, convey and quit-claim unto the said Collamore his heirs and assigns a certain piece or parcel of land, situate in Lawrence, aforesaid, described as follows, viz: One lot or parcel of land situate on Ohio Street, and numbered twenty four, on said Ohio Street, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging. Said lot or parcel of land is shown on a plat of the said Town or City of Lawrence, surveyed by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, and is numbered Twenty four Ohio, Street, on said plat.

To Have and to Hold the above released premises to the said Collamore, and his heirs and assigns, to his, and their use and behoof, forever. And I, the said for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators do covenant with the said Collamore his heirs and assigns that the premises are free from all incumbrances, made or suffered by me. And that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators, shall warrant and defend the same to the said Collamore, his heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me, but against none other.
