

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid premises, unto

so that neither I, nor my heirs nor assigns shall here-
after have or claim any right, title, or interest in
said lots or any part thereof.

And I further covenant and agree and bind my-
self unto the said Judd, his heirs and assigns in
the sum of five hundred dollars, to convey unto the
said Judd, whatever title I may hereafter obtain from
the Trustees of the town site of Lawrence, said Territory,
or from any other person, whenever such said title shall
by me be obtained.
