Finley his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the Survey made by A. D. Searl, C. D. 1854, to-wit:- Lot numbered one hundred and forty one (141) on Penn. Street.

And we Josiah Miller and R. G. Elliott, aforesaid, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of eighty dollars to be paid to the said James A. Finley, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which we shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whatsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
