 of the sum of Thirty dollars, to me in hand paid by John M.
 Cox of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed and
 by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said
 John M. Cox, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
 forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand in and
 to the following described land, situate and lying in the
 City of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit:-
 Lot numbered one hundred and ninety-eight (198)
 Mississippi Street, agreeable ^{to a} survey and plan of said City made
 by A. D. Pearl Oct. 1854, being one of the lots conveyed to me
 by the Trustees of the town site of Lawrence.

And I, Ferdinand Fuller, aforesaid, my heirs executors,
 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these
 presents in the sum of Sixty dollars, to said John M. Cox, aforesaid,
 his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly
 make over and convey unto him or them such title as I may
 receive from the Trustees of the Town site of Lawrence or from
 any person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above
 described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the
 privileged and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
