

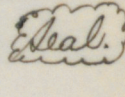

Harrington, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:- Lot No. (20) Twenty Rhode Island Street, of Share No. (69) Sixty nine.

And Lewis Timothy Litchfield, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of (\$200.00) two hundred dollars, to said Jacob D. Harrington, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property.

To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
