

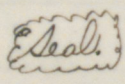

Wright, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars to me in hand paid, by Walter Pellett, of Lawrence K.T., the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Walter Pellett, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot No. One hundred and three Rhode Island Street,
And I, C. A. Wright, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of two hundred dollars, to said Walter Pellett, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons, whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
