Hunt, for myself, and my heirs, executors, administrators do covenant with the said Collamore his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Collamore his heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me, but against none other. And for the consideration aforesaid, and for divers other good and valuable considerations, Henrietta H. Hunt wife of said Francis A. do hereby release and quit claim unto the said Collamore his heirs and assigns, all my right, claim or possibility of dower, in or out of the aforesaid premises.
