Said lot is shown on a plat of said town or City of Lawrence according to the survey of A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, and is numbered sixty three on said Tennessee Street, on said plat. To Have, and to Hold the above released premises to the said Collamore and his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever, And I the said Henry Campbell, for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators do covenant with the said Collamore, his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me. And that I will, and my heirs, executors, or administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Collamore, his heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other.
