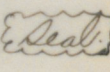


Know all Men by these Presents, That I, John Baldwin, of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Forty dollars to me in hand paid by Maltravers Solomon of aforesaid place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Maltravers Solomon his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit:-

Lot No. one hundred sixty seven, Vermont Street (167). According to a survey made by A. D. Searl, 1854, A.D. And I, John Baldwin, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars, to said Maltravers Solomon, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
