

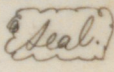
Know all Men by these Presents, that I, James R. White of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars, to me in hand paid by Edwin Bond of the Town of Lawrence, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said Edwin Bond his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854, to-wit:-

Lot No. Twenty two Rhode Island Street.

And I, James R. White, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of six hundred dollars to said Edwin Bond, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person or persons whosoever, to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
