bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain,<sup>do</sup>  
and quit-claim unto the said G. L. Andre, his heirs, executors, ad-  
ministrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim,<sup>to</sup>  
demand, in and to the following described land, situate and lying  
in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit -  
lot number one hundred and sixty five (165) on Vermont  
Street.

And I, P. H. Woodward, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,  
administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these pre-  
sents, in the sum of one hundred dollars, to said G. L. Andre  
aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well  
and truly make over and convey unto him or them such title as I  
may receive from the Trustees or any power or persons or persons  
whatever, to any and all of the above described property, To Have  
and to Hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging, forever.
