 administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these  
 presents in the sum of \$50.00 dollars, to said C. C. Hyde,  
 aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to  
 well and truly make over and convey unto him or them  
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the  
 said City of Lawrence, or from any person or persons  
 whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property.  
 To Have and to Hold the same with all the privileges and  
 appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
