

This Indenture made this second day of June, A. D. 1855, between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John P. Hood, William A. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson, Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties of the first part, and Samuel Y. Lum party of the second part. Witnesseth, that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from one William A. R. Lykins to the above Trustees, creating said Trustees, and in consideration of one dollar in hand paid by said Samuel Y. Lum of said Town and Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have conveyed, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do convey, release, and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all right, title, and interest in and to certain lots of land, situated and being in Lawrence, First Council District, Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl, October, A. D. 1854, as follows, to-wit:-

Share number one hundred ninety five (195) containing lots as follows-Louisiana street eighty three (83). Park twenty nine (29) N-Hampshire street sixty two (62). Ohio street one hundred twenty nine (129) Rhode Island street twenty eight (28) N. York street one hundred one (101) Indiana street one hundred thirty five (135) N. Jersey street three (3) Tennessee street one hundred twenty eight (128) and one hundred thirty (130) Mississippi street two hundred thirty two (232) and lot Massachusetts street twenty six (26).

To Have and to Hold the aforesaid quit-claimed premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, so that neither we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors, or any person claiming by, from or under us or them, shall have any right, title, interest, claim, or demand in or to the aforesaid premises, or any part thereof, and we hereby covenant and agree to warrant and defend against all persons claiming any right, title or interest under the said Trustees, their heirs or successors.
