D. Searl, Oct. A.D. 1854, being the same lot I purchased of Joel Groves, And I the said Norman N. Chambers, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five hundred dollars to the said Hall, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them a good and valid title, such as the said Norman N.
