

Know all men by these presents that we, Charles Robinson, Samuel V. Linn, Albert O. Searl and Oliver H. Causcom of Lawrence in District Number one in Kansas Territory Trustees of the Lawrence Association have apportioned, and charged by said Association, and by these presents do apportion unto Silly Gilbert of Lawrence in said district and Territory certain lots of land and interests to wit, Lot number fifteen (15) in Block number eleven (11) Lot number five (5) in Block number forty (40) Lot number thirteen (13) in Block number twenty nine (29) Lot number nine (9) in Block number eighteen (18) Lot number eighteen (18) in Block number fifteen (15) in Lawrence and said district and territory, according to the City survey and plot made by J. D. Searl A.D. 1852, and the remaining part or share of the lands belonging to the Lawrence Association belonging unto the said Gilbert as a member of said Association, reserving unto the said Association the power to collect and assess such and all tax or taxes required to pay the expenses of surveying and other necessary expenses accruing unto the said Association on account of or touching said premises.
