T. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell ~~and~~ quit claim unto the said Lyman Allen, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in ~~and~~ both the following described land, situated ~~and~~ lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl, A.D. 1854, to wit: —

The south half of lot number Twenty Nine Massachusetts Street ~~and~~ the house and appurtenances thereto —

And I, John Doy aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, am held ~~and~~ fairly bound by these Presents, in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to Lyman Allen aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over ~~and~~ convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any ~~and~~ all of the above described property, to Han ~~and~~ to Hold the same, with all the fortifications and appurtenances thereto belonging forever —
