whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold,
conveyed, quit-claimed, and by these Presents do bargain, sell
convey and quit-claim unto the said Henry Campbell his heirs,
executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right,
title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described
land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory
of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. J. Padd, A.D. 1856, to-wit:-

Lot No. Five Pinckney Street

And I Levi Gates Jr. aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by
these Presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, to
Henry Campbell aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him
or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees
of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person
or persons whatsoever, to any and all of the above described
property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges
and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
