

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, C. E. Searnard of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of the Town and Territory aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit-claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim, with the said Henry Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand, in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seal, A. D. 1856, to wit:

Tracts No. one hundred and fifty (150) on Ohio Island Street, and one hundred and eighty seven (187) Lawrence Street.

And I, C. E. Searnard aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound, by these Presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to Henry Campbell aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same, with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
