 conveyed, quit claimed, and by these Presents do bargain
 sell and quit claim, unto the said Campbell his
 heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all
 my right title, interest claim and demand in and
 to the following described land, situate and lying in
 the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas - ac-
 cording to the survey made by A. D. Trail, A.D. 1834, to wit:

Lot number Ninety three (93) Connection Street

And A. Samuel Merrill aforesaid, my heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns, are held and
 firmly bound, by these Presents, in the sum of Fifty
 Dollars to Henry Campbell aforesaid his heirs,
 executors, administrators and assigns, to well and
 truly make over and convey unto him or them all
 the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of
 the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power
 or person or persons whatsoever, to any and all of
 the above described property to have and to hold the
 same with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
 unto belonging forever.
