

This Indenture made this second day of June
 A.D. 1833 between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Grover, John T. Wood,
 William H. R. Lykins and George W. Hutchinson Trustees
 of the Town Site of Lawrence, Kansas Territory, parties
 of the first part, and Edward Winslow party of the
 second part Witnesseth, That in compliance with the
 provision contained in the Deed in Trust from one William
 H. R. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trust,
 and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand
 paid by said Edward Winslow, of said Town and
 Territory, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 have conveyed, released and quit claimed, and by these
 Presents do convey, release and quit claim unto the
 said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 all right title and interest in and to certain lots of
 land situated and being in Lawrence, First Council
 District Kansas Territory, and designated on the
 Lithographed Chart of said Town as surveyed
 by A. D. Seal, October A.D. 1834 as follows. A wit-
 ness I have number One Hundred twenty One (121). Con-
 taining lots as follows Kentucky Street twenty five (25)
 Kentucky Street Eighty One (81) Rhode Island Street
 Seventy Seven (77) Louisiana Street two hundred twenty seven
 (227) Pennsylvania Street Seventy (70) New York Street
 one hundred forty (140) Indiana Street two hundred
 twenty five (225) Hampshire Street one hundred
 seventy four (174) Delaware Street one hundred one
 (101) and one hundred three (103) Indiana Street one
 hundred twenty two (122) and lot Kentucky Street Eighteen (18)

To have and to hold the aforesaid quit claimed premises
 with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging
 unto the said party of the second part so that neither
 we, said Trustees, our heirs or successors or any person claiming
