Phillips, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. S. Seal A. D. 1854, to wit: One undivided half interest in Lots Numbers Ten (10) and Fourteen (14) Park, One hundred and forty (140) Rhode Island Street, Ninety three (93) and Ninety seven (97) New Hampshire Street. One hundred and two (102) Ky. Street. One hundred and seventy one (171) Tennessee Street. One hundred and forty two (142) One hundred and eighty six (186) One hundred and eighty eight (188) and Two hundred and five (205) Ohio Street. And Two hundred and nineteen (219) Louisiana Street

And I, C. E. Searns aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, am held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Five Hundred dollars to Edwin A. Phillips aforesaid his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property, To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therein belonging, forever.
