have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents
do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said D. H. Weir
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever all my
right, title, interest, claim, and demands in and to the
following described lands situate and lying in the Town
of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according to the sur-
vey made by A. D. Seale A.D. 1854 to wit:

Lots No One Hundred and fourteen (114) N. y St. One Hundred
and Sixty four (164) Term St. One Hundred and six, and One
Hundred and twelve (106, 102). La St. And S. H. m. ^{Turner Sampson} of the
Town of Lawrence and Territory aforesaid my heirs, executors, ad-
ministrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of Five Hundred dollars to - D. H.

Weir — aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns to well and truly make over and convey
unto him or them all the title I which I shall receive from
the Trustees of said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or
person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above
described property. To Have and To Hold the same, with all
the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever
