Weir his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demands in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A. A. Seal A.D. 1854 to wit: Lot No One Hundred and eighty seven (187) Town St. A.D. Henry Campbell of the Town of Lawrence and Territory aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns to ~~sell~~ ^{by these presents} are held and firmly bound in the sum of One Hundred dollars to said D. H. Weir aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of ^{the} said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
