is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, sold and quit-
-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-
-claim unto the said George James his heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns forever, all my right title, in-
-terest, claim and demands in and to the following de-
-scribed land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence
in the State of Kansas, according to the survey made by
A.D. Seal A.D. 1854. to wit:

Lot Number One hundred and fifty (150)
Louisiana Street,

And I Ferdinand Fuller, aforesaid my heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
by these presents in the sum of Eighty dollars, to said
George James, aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and
assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or
them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees
of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power, or person
or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described
property, To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges
and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
