presents do bargain, sell, and quit-claim unto the said
O. A. Bassett his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, for-
ever all my right, title, interest, claim, and demands, in
and to the following described land, situate and lying in
the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas, according
to the survey made by T. D. Seal, A.D. 1854, to wit:

Lots Number Seventy eight (78) Eighty (80) and Eighty
two (82) Kentucky Street.

And I Elizabeth S. Whitney aforesaid my heirs, exe-
cutors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
by these presents in the sum of Four hundred dollars
to said O. A. Bassett aforesaid, his heirs, executors, admin-
istrators and assigns to well and truly make over and con-
vey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive
from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from
any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all
of the above described property. To Have and To Hold the same
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging
forever.
