Swope his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land: situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas according to the survey made by A. D. Seal, & D. 1854, to wit Lots Nos thirty five (35) & thirty three (33) Pennsylvania Street.

And J. P. A. Bassett aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Seventy Dollars to said William C. Swope aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any person, or person or persons whomsoever, to any and all the above described property, so that and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
