has bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents do
bargain, sell, quit claim unto the said John Spurr, his heirs, exe-
cutors, administrators and assigns, forever, all his right title, interest
claim and demands in and to the following described land, situate
and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas accor-
ding to the survey made by A.D. Seail A.D. 1854. to wit:

No. Nineteen (19) Rhode Islands Street.

And Amos Finch aforesaid his heirs, executors, administra-
tors, and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the
sum of One hundred & Twenty dollars, to John Spurr aforesaid, his
heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well and truly make
over and convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive
from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any person
or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described
property To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and
appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
