paid by the Trustees of the American Unitarian Association for the
erection of a Church Building in Lawrence, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have bargain, sold, and quit claimed,
and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto
the said Association, their executors, administrators and assigns,
forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demands in
and to the following described lands, situate and lying in the
Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the
survey made by A. D. Beal, A. D. 1854 to wit:

Lot One hundred & twenty nine (129) on Ohio Street.

And I the said, W. J. Lane aforesaid, my heirs, executors, ad-
ministrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of One hundred dollars to the said Trust-
ees aforesaid, their executors, administrators and assigns to
well and truly make over and convey unto him or them, all
the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said
Town of Lawrence, or from any person or persons
whomever, to any and all of the above described property
to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appur-
tenances thereto belonging, forever.
