

Know all men by these presents that I Josiah G. Fuller, of the Town  
of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for a consideration of the sum of Sixty Dollars  
then in hand paid by Robert S. Norton of the Town & Territory aforesaid  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, conveyed, quit claimed  
and given up possession of, sum by these Presents do sell, convey, quit claim  
and give up possession of, unto the said Norton, and to his heirs assigns  
for ever a certain lot or parcel of land, situated lying in the Town of Lawrence  
in the Territory of Kansas, described according to the Lithographical Chart of  
Madison as surveyed by J. L. Hall, A.D. 1854 and known to wit, Lot number  
Fiftieth (50) Madison Street, together with all the privileges and appurtenances  
thereunto belonging. And also all the estate right, title, interest and claim  
whatsoever, as well in law as equity of the said Fuller, of and to the above described premises.  
And I the said Fuller for myself for my heirs Executors  
Administrators and assigns, do covenant and agree to and  
with the said Norton his heirs, Executors, Administrators  
and assigns that I have not done or suffered any act or  
thing, whereby the above described premises or any part  
thereof now are or any time after shall be encroached, quit claimed  
or encumbered in any manner whatsoever. And further know by  
these presents that I the said Fuller owe, due and owing unto  
the said Norton his heirs and assigns, in the sum of One Hundred  
Dollars to be paid unto the said Norton his heirs to which payment  
well and truly to be made I bind myself my heirs Executors Admini-  
strators by these presents Now the condition of this obligation is such  
that if the said Fuller his heirs or assigns shall convey unto  
the said Norton his heirs or assigns whatever further title may  
& shall be unto the said Fuller conveyed by the trustee of the  
Town site of Lawrence, said Territory, or by or from any person  
or persons whosoever, or by any power whatsoever, by virtue  
of Patent issuing from the Land Office at Washington, unto  
William H. R. Tyler or one Robin Robitaille, a Wyandot Indian  
or by virtue of any other authority; at such time as said title shall  
be so doing conveyed, then this obligation shall be wholly void and  
of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force - In Testimony
