ministrators, and assigns, forever, all my right title interest claim
and demands in and to the following described land, situate and
lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according
to the survey made by A. D. Seal, A. D. 1854, to wit:

Lot Number Three Hundred and Thirty three (333)
Indiana Street. And I John A. Saddle aforesaid, my
heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns are held and
firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Forty dollars
to Lydia S. Wall aforesaid, her heirs, executors adminis-
trators and assigns, to well and truly make over and
convey unto him or them all the title which I shall
receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence
or from any power, or person or persons whomsoever, to any
and all of the above described property, To Have and To Hold
the same with all of the privileges and appurtenances therunto
belonging, forever.
