Bliss his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever
all my right, title, interest claim, and demand in and to the
following described land: situate and lying in the Town of
Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made
by A. D. Seal, A.D. 1854, to wit:

Lot 420. One hundred and sixty one (161) Kentucky Street,
And I Chas Robinson aforesaid, my heirs, executors, ad-
ministrators, and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of forty dollars, to said H. J. Bliss
aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to well
and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the
title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said
Town of Lawrence, or from any power or person or persons
whomsoever to any and all of the above described property.
To Have and To Hold the same with all the privileges and
appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
