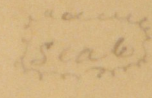

Elliott of the Town of Lawrence, Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Henry Williams, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest claim, and demand in and to the following described lands, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, Kansas, according to the survey made by A.D. Searl S.S. 1854 to wit: Lot numbered twenty four, Third Street (24),

And I Robert G. Elliott aforesaid my heirs executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Forty dollars to said Henry Williams, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person, or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property. To Have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seal this twenty eighth day of May A.D. 1856
