the sum of One Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Egbert of
Franklin Kt. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained,
sold, and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, and quit claim
unto the said Henry Egbert his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, forever
all my right title, interest claim and demand in and to the following de-
scribed land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of
Kansas according to the survey made by J.D. Seab. A.D. 1854, to wit:

Lot No. Seventy and (70) New Hampshire Street.

And I Jacob Bollman aforesaid my heirs, executors, administra-
tors and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of
One hundred dollars, to said Henry Egbert aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the
title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons whatsoever, to and
all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever
unto the said Henry Egbert I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this 11th day of June A.D. 1856.
