sold and quit claimed, and by these presents do bargain, sell
and quit claim unto the said John C. Douglass his heirs,
executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my rights
title, interest claim and demand in and to the following
described lands situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in
the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D.
Hearl, A.D. 1854 to wit:

Lot 22 (10) West 1st Street, and One Hundred
and seven (107) and One Hundred and nine (109) Delaware Street.

And I Henry Campbell after said my heirs, exec-
utors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly
bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred
dollars to said John C. Douglass aforesaid his heirs or
executors administrators and assigns, to well and truly re-
ceive and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall
receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence
or from any person or person who may come to any
title of the above described property To Have and To
hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
unto belonging, forever.
