K.T. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
bargained, sold and quit-claimed, and by these presents
to bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said E. A. Wright
his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand
in and to the following described land, situate and
lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas,
according to the survey made by A. D. Seal, A.D. 1854
to wit: Lot No. Eighty-four (84) Vermont Street.

Lot No. One (1) Pinkney Street.

And I Ferdinand Fuller aforesaid my heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound, by
these presents in the sum of five hundred dollars, to said
E. A. Wright aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto
him or them all the title which I shall receive from the
Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any person
or persons whomsoever, to any and all of the
above described property, to have and to hold the same with
all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, forever.
