 to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of aforesaid
 place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
 bargained, sold, and quit claimed and by these presents do
 bargain, sell, and quit claim unto the said Henry
 Campbell his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand
 in and to the following described land situate, and
 lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the State of Kansas
 according to the survey made by A. B. Seal, A. D. 1854
 to wit: Lot No. Thirty five (35) Vermont Street.

And I John T. Tappan aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns, do hold and firmly bound by
 these presents in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, to said
 Henry Campbell aforesaid, his heirs, executors, adminis-
 trators and assigns, to well and truly make over and convey
~~and to hold~~ the title, which I shall receive from
 the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any
 person, or person or persons whomsoever, and all
 of the above described property, to have and to hold, the
 same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing, forever.
