

Know all Men by these Presents, that I, *Samuel S. Adams*,
Governor of the Territory of Kansas, for
and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and seventy
five dollars, to me in hand paid by *Samuel S. Adams* of
the Town of Lawrence of record, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have granted, sold and quit-claimed and by these
presents do grant, sell and quit-claim to the said *Samuel S. Adams*
all my right, title, interest claim and demand in and to the portion
of landed land, situate and lying in the Town of Law-
rence, in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made
by *A. D. Seale* A.D. 1854 to wit:

Lot No. (39) Thirty Nine Acres & 25 Cents

And I, *Samuel S. Adams*, my heirs, executors, ad-
ministrators and assigns, are hereby and jointly bound by these presents
in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to *Samuel S. Adams*
of record, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, to well
and lawfully make over and convey unto him or them all the
right which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of
Lawrence, or from any person or persons whomsoever
to any and all of the above described subject, to have and to
hold to the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto
in anywise belonging, forever.
