Brooks, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns forever all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit: Lot No. one hundred and twenty nine (129) Rhode Island Street as shown by a survey made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854.

And I, Henry Campbell, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred dollars to said H. R. Brooks, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence, or any power, person or persons whatsoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
