

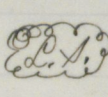
Know all men by these Presents, That I Amory

 is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and
 quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell
 and quit-claim unto the said Hilder, his heirs exec-
 utors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my
 right, title, interest, claim and demand in and
 to the following described land situate and
 lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory
 of Kansas, according to the survey made by A.
 D. Seab A. D. 1854, to-wit:- Lot number Twenty
 seven (27) on New Jersey Street,

And I, Amory Hetherby, aforesaid, my heirs, executors,
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly
 bound by these presents in the sum of seventy five
 dollars to Abraham Hilder aforesaid, his heirs
 executors, administrators and assigns to well and
 truly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the
 Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any
 power or person or persons whomsoever to any and
 all of the above described property, to have
 and to hold the same with all the privileges and
 appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
