D. Searl A. D. 1854, to-wit: - Lot number fifty nine (59) Louisiana Street. Being the same which Arthur Gunther by his deed bearing date the twenty sixth day of June A. And I, Patrick Cronen, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to Denis Moriarty, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
