Leiby, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land, situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Searl A.D. 1854, to-wit: - Lot number fifty two (52) Vermont Street - and Charles Garrett aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars to the said J. Leiby aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which he shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whosoever to any and all of the above described property to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
