

Know all Men by these Presents, that I Turner Sampson of the Town of Lawrence, Territory of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Campbell of aforesaid place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell and quit-claim unto the said Henry Campbell, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, to-wit: - Lots No. Fifty four (54) Ohio St. and eighty seven (87) Maryland Street, according to a survey made by A. D. Seale, A. D. 1854.

And I, Turner Sampson, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of one thousand dollars to said Henry Campbell, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town of Lawrence or from any ^{other} person or persons power or powers whosoever to any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, forever.
