Said lot is shown on a plat of said town of Lawrence according to the survey by A. D. Searl, A. D. 1854. and on said plat is numbered twenty six. To have and to hold the above released premises to the said Collamore and his heirs and assigns to his and theirs use and behoof forever and the said John C. Archibald for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Collamore his heirs and assigns, ^{that the said premises} are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Collamore, his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other.
