Blood, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the City of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas, according to the survey made by A. D. Seale, A. D. 1854 to-wit: - Lot Twelve (12) on Park.

And I, Hugh Cameron, aforesaid, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of twenty dollars to said S. H. Blood, aforesaid, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said City of Lawrence, or from any person or persons whosoever to any and all of the above described property, to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging, forever.
